

Historical Figure Presentations

For this assignment, you will choose one woman who has been involved in politics/the political process in the United States. You will then craft an oral presentation that profiles that person and explains their political involvement.

Your presentation must include:

- The person's name and background; when and where they lived; their significance
- What the woman is most well-known for politically
- Connections to our class themes
- At least one primary source document on that person. (This primary source can either be posted to Canvas or handed out in class).
- At least two supplementary images, objects, or documents
- Visuals of some sort, via handouts or digital presentation.
- Analysis of the historical figure and the primary source(s) you choose in connection to the theme and readings for the class
- Bibliography of web and scholarly sources – at least 3.

Your presentation can take any form you would like: a PowerPoint with a talk; a talk with handouts; a short film or media presentation. Your presentation should last 7-8 minutes, with an additional 2-3 minutes for questions.

You must cite all of your sources, and you should rely on reputable, scholarly sources.
